Congress promised to pay the United Nations. In 1999 Congress passed the bi-partisan Helms-Biden legislation promising that America would pay its UN arrears if the UN met certain conditions. The United Nations kept its part of the deal, undertaking its own reforms and meeting the Helms-Biden conditions. Now, it's time to keep our promise.

Although both the House and the Senate have voted in separate bills to release the second Helms-Biden installment of \$582 million, the payment is stalled. Congress must end this legislative stalemate now. Otherwise, at the opening of the UN General Assembly on September 11, the U.S. will once again be the UN's largest debtor.

Congress must act and honor our commitment to the UN — it's long overdue. Congress must release U.S. funds for peacekeeping and pay our overdue bills.
